<p>24-12 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Consider where you want to live and research areas including education options if relevant. It is particularly advisable to start considering education options early if you have children with SEND who will move schools. <input type="checkbox"/> Think about your housing options <input type="checkbox"/> Attend a JSHAO housing brief or complete online if you haven't already <input type="checkbox"/> Attend Financial Aspects of Resettlement (FAR) brief (spouse/partner and SL eligible) <input type="checkbox"/> Talk to your HIVE information officer who may know about relevant events planned on unit that can help with your planning, may have information about different areas you are thinking of moving to or useful contacts for you on a range of topics. <input type="checkbox"/> Service leaver should see the Resettlement and Education Clerk (REC) to be referred on to their Regional Resettlement Advisor (RRO) and book in for their mandatory Resettlement Advisory Brief (RAB) in order to access resettlement entitlements and support from the Career Transition Partnership (CTP), including attending the Career Transition Workshop. 	
<p>12-9 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> SL to increase networking and job hunting, increasing profile and working with Career Advisors at CTP if needed <input type="checkbox"/> Inform Med Centre of intention to leave for SL and family if applicable and check procedure <input type="checkbox"/> Plan budget and research costs associated with transition <input type="checkbox"/> Go firm on your housing option see if there are events scheduled on your unit to help with advice on housing or it may not be too late to attend a JSHAO brief or complete it online 	
<p>9-6 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Register children for new schools if appropriate <input type="checkbox"/> SL to engage with station staff and/or DIO's Loss of Entitlement Team regarding vacating your SFA if appropriate. These or your HIVE may be able to advise if you are worried about the timelines for vacating and think you might have a case to remain in your accommodation for longer <input type="checkbox"/> Seek pensions advice from the Forces Pension Society or other if you haven't already 	
<p>6-3 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Arrange pre-move out of SFA <input type="checkbox"/> SL final medical and dental examinations <input type="checkbox"/> Find local GPs and dentists and arrange to start registration 	
<p>3-1 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> SL to complete and return Armed Forces Pension Scheme Form Pen 1 (must be completed 6 weeks before the final date of service) <input type="checkbox"/> Move out of SFA (if permission to extend occupation has not been obtained) <input type="checkbox"/> Arrange transfer of information from children's schools if moving <input type="checkbox"/> SL will commence terminal leave in their last month of service
