The Single Living Accommodation Survey is now open!

This Single Living Accommodation (SLA) survey is a key opportunity for you to share your views on the current offer and shape the future of Defence SLA accommodation.

The survey aims to find out:

- Your experiences of Single Living Accommodation
- How Single Living Accommodation is being used
- What you want and need from Single Living Accommodation

It is vital that as many Service Personnel as possible complete the survey to provide the strongest evidence to really shape the future of accommodation in Defence, regardless of whether you currently reside in SLA.

Lieutenant General James Swift, Chief of Defence Personnel explains:

"An important task for the Department is to understand the attitudes and opinions of its workforce on Single Living Accommodation. On 20th April 2022 we are launching the Single Living Accommodation Lived Experience survey. I strongly encourage all Service Personnel to take part. This is your chance to share your views on the current offer and shape the future of Defence accommodation. The information

you provide will enable us to gain a greater awareness of your current attitudes about SLA and it will provide us with the opportunity to take necessary action in a timely fashion, if required."
